Hello,

Here is a quick update into what we have been up to so far at Preschool as well as some things we have coming up...

Firstly, we were so pleased to welcome everyone back in September, all of the children settled back in fantastically - it was like we had never been away! They quickly adapted to the new routine...wash hands, play, wash hands, play...and repeat!



For the past few weeks we have been looking at Autumn and the changing seasons, alongside following the children's interests. We made vegetable soup together, made playdough, looked at printing with apples, vegetables and leaves, made leaf collages, explored conkers by weighing them, rolling them down tubes and in paint, counting them and much more! We have also observed our caterpillars changing into cocoons and then recently emerging, as well as welcoming back Shelly, our giant African land snail! We also have some pumpkin related activities planned for next week.



Our interests at the moment have largely been in role play - mostly playing mummies, daddies and babies. This has allowed the children to develop their social skills, language and communication and imagination. Other fascinations have been dinosaurs, and castles! This has lead to lots of creativity - painting a big box to make a castle and creating interesting dinosaur lands with sticks and pine cones. We have also been very busy outside, as usual!

Coming up...

- We break up for half term on **Friday 23rd October** and return on **Tuesday 3rd November**.
- **Ventilation and warm clothing:** Whilst we spend plenty of time outside, in order to reduce the risk of transmission of Covid-19 we have the door open for

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extended periods, often all day long to aid ventilation. We are lucky that the Marigold room is equipped with plenty of warm radiators, however please ensure that your child is dressed for Preschool with plenty of layers so that they can add or remove clothing as necessary to keep warm, especially as the weather starts to get colder over the coming months.

- **Updated Covid Alert level: High** - As you know Cheshire West and Chester has now entered **Tier 2 - Covid Alert level:high**. This brings new guidance on what people can do with regards to socialising with others. It does not require us to change any of our current practices at Preschool and we will be continuing as we have been.
